Match Captains' Reports

Brian Hicks u-180 Captain

We managed to field stronger teams than last year, and won two of our six matches. However the opposition also had stronger teams, Oxfordshire in particular, against whom we lost 8.5-11.5 at home, and by 6 – 14 away. Against Berkshire the score was the same in both matches (12.5 – 7.5), with both teams winning their respective home match. We also had the same score in both matches against Hampshire (9 – 11), this time the away team winning both matches. I hope we can find more 130 to 140 graded players next year.

Chris Stothert u-125 Captain

As you will all know, this is my first year as Under 125 Captain. I am very pleased with the efforts of my regular players, being out-graded on every board and putting up magnificent performances.

Unfortunately, there are many players who play in the Bucks League whose grading merits them to play on the top 8 boards, but they do not seem interested, or are too busy, to play County chess. This is a shame when other counties can field up to twelve boards with players of over a 100 grading.

The lack of senior players able to commit to play County chess games has led to my taking the opportunity to play four junior players. I have been very pleased with all their performances but would like to make special mention of the performances of Ilya Iyengar and Edward Basham who have really excelled themselves. I believe that all my junior players have a very good future in the game and that, if they continue playing as they have this year, both Ilya and Edward may soon be playing in the Under 180s.

As for the results, we drew 7 - 7 with Hampshire, being outgraded on all boards. We lost 7 - 8 to Berkshire, 4 - 12 to Oxon, 8Y2 -51/2, to Hampshire and 12 - 4 again to Oxon which is quite consistent to say the least.

Maybe next year we will be able to get far better results.. One can but hope!

Junior Organiser's Report 2006

Fred asks us the question "how can we get more people to play serious chess?"

I ask a different one "Can the decline in the number of children playing serious chess, and the inevitable knock-on to adult chess, be halted?"

In the 1980s more than thirty schools could "field" competitive teams. There were four leagues in the High Wycombe area and over one thousand children playing in the school chess clubs.

The situation is now very different, Even the Schools which see chess as a valuable educational tool cannot obtain chess teachers and when I am unable to visit schools the number of children with chess skills will be very few indeed.

I believe that junior chess, which is now managed on an ad-hoc basis resulting in the poorest team results in our 40 year history, can return to a more formal arrangement drawing in many more parents. With more publicity of the game, and drawing my net as wide as possible, I hope to build a County Under 9 Squad of sixteen players capable of playing the mature game necessary to put Bucks back at the forefront of the National chess scene. The task Will then be to make chess important enough to those players for them to keep playing through future years. EasyR

Encouraged by developments at the Wycombe & Hazlemere Chess Club as Junior Organiser I will this year repeat the informal league ~ successfully in 2004 on Sunday afternoons with teams of adults and juniors. This time probably in the form of a ladder with matches on Wednesday and Friday evenings.

Next year I will publish a 75 year history of Bucks Junior Chess illustrating the ups and downs, highlighting the most successful teams and players.

Will it survive another 75 years?

i) After a slow start, this is working well. Could club secretaries point out to fellow members that www.buckschess.uk.eu.org maintains an up-to-date list of fixtures, results, tables, club information and occasional news.

ii) Bucks CC provides a service www.bucksinfo.net which allows various groups within the community to set up a simple presence. This is done through a series of forms and point and click. Aylesbury and Gerrards Cross have the led the way with basic entries already. If you decide to take advantage of the service, I would ask that:

- a) you let me know the URL of your site so that the BCCA site can link to it
- b) you provide a link to the BCCA site
- c) you check that club information on your site is consistent with that on the BCCA site.

iii) There has been little ongoing development. My two current concerns will be guaranteeing continuity of service and providing a user-friendly interface for entering results. I hope to provide some enhancements before the next season begins.
