Treasurer Resignation Statement

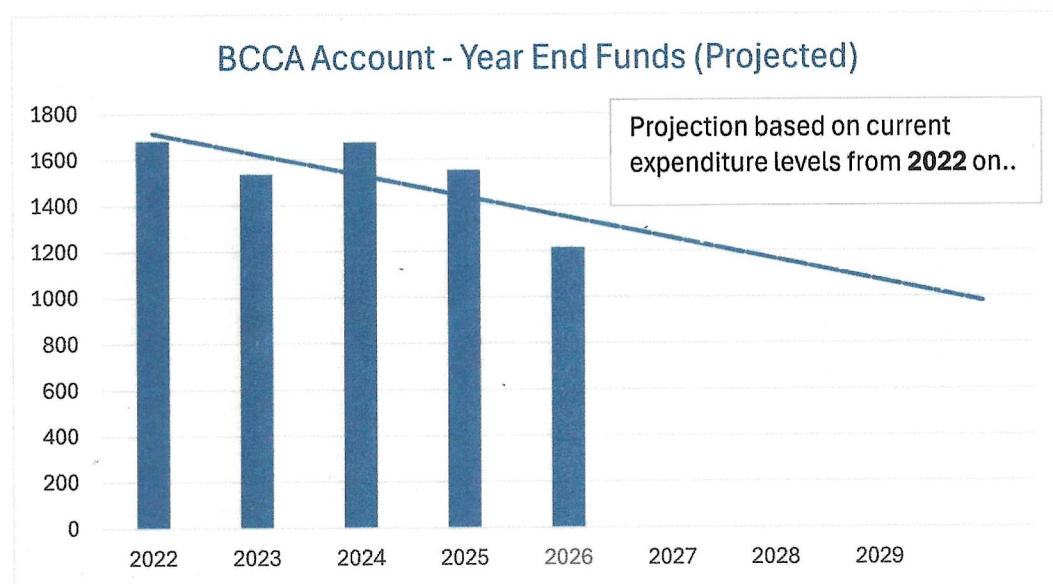
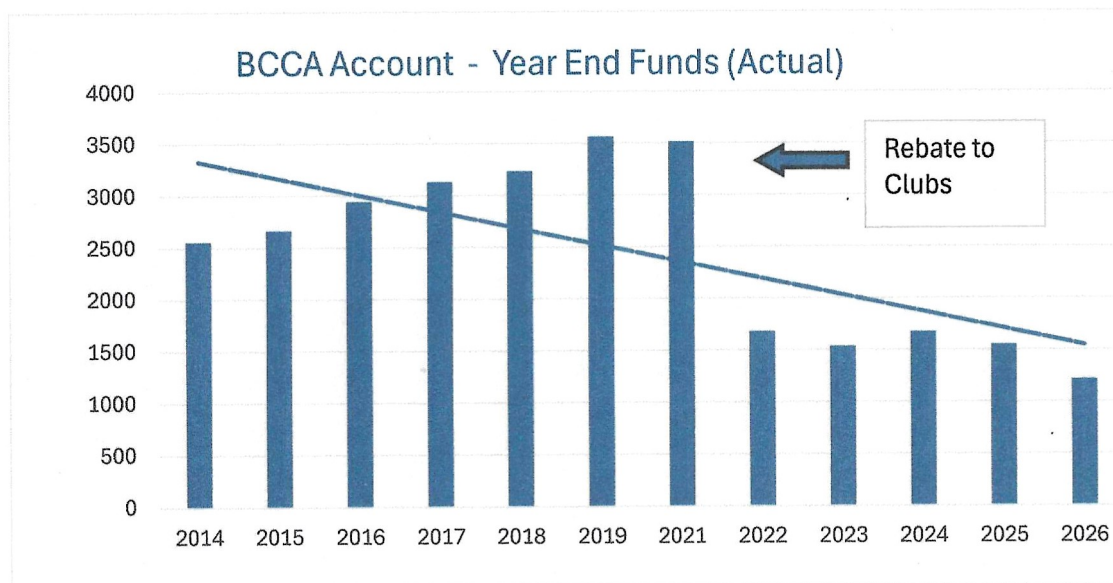
The Honourary Treasurer hereby submits his Resignation effective **latest** 31st August 2027. The Association will be required to have a new Treasurer in place before that date or by the time of the 2027/8 AGM should that occur earlier. The current Treasurer will **cease** to take any responsibility for the Association funds thereafter. Obviously the sooner a new Treasurer is appointed the better.

I would like to point out that the trend in a reduction of funds has been due to actions proposed and agreed by the BCCA Committee rather than by any great munificence on the part of the Treasurer! The present balance is GBP 1201.27 and at the current rate of expenditure the balance should be around GBP 1,000 by 2028/9 (or possibly less). I personally feel that bearing in mind the current ambitions of the BCCA a balance of this amount is just about adequate, but certainly anything less than £ 1,000 would be concerning. Should the outlook change for example by introducing new Tournaments, funding Juniors or reintroducing Prizes for League tournaments etc. then different policies may have to be introduced by the Committee to enable suitable funding.

I have attached some Projections illustrating the expenditure as well as presenting the BCCA Accounts for the final time.
